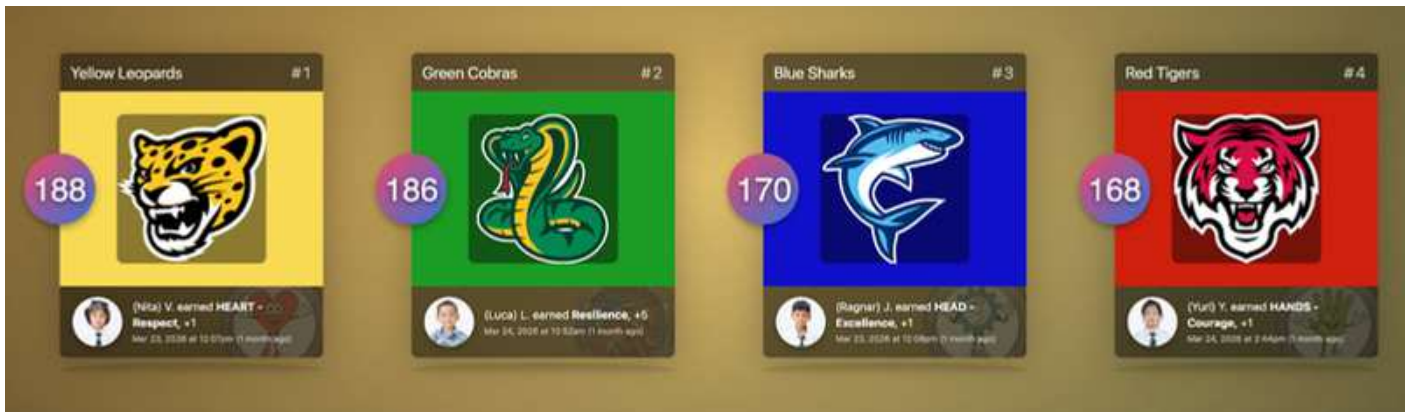


House Points!
