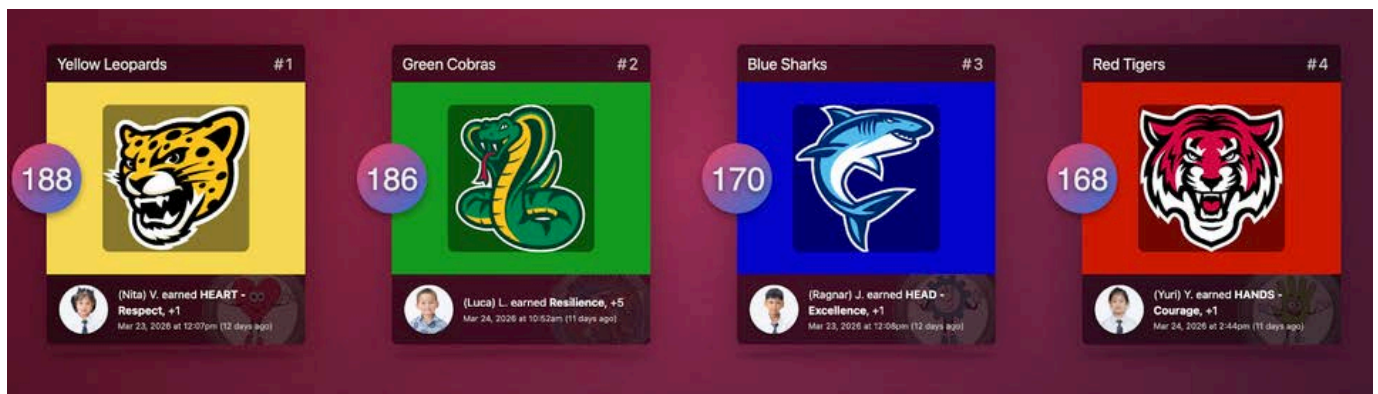




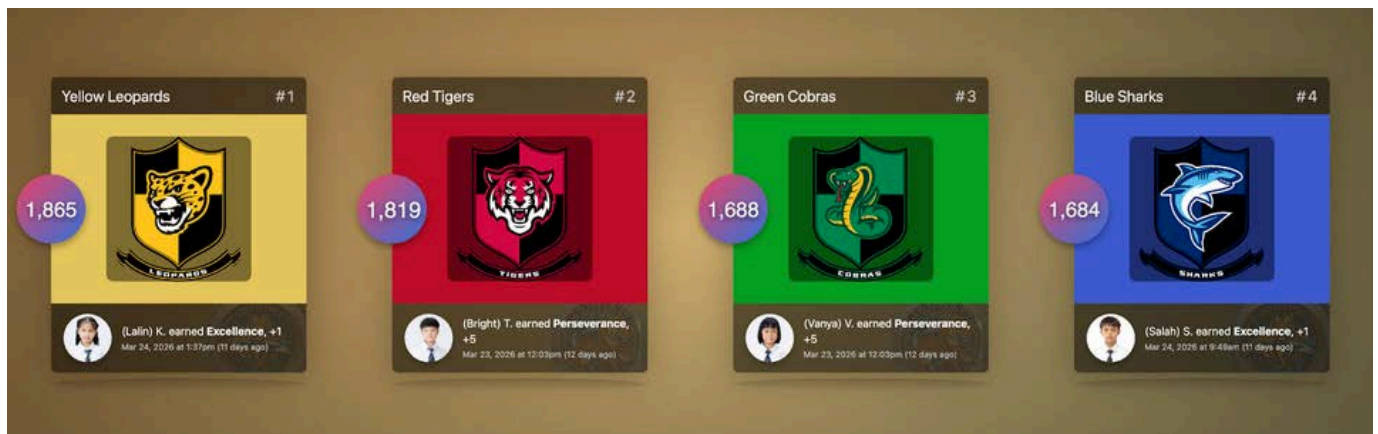
## House points - Term 2

## Closing Note

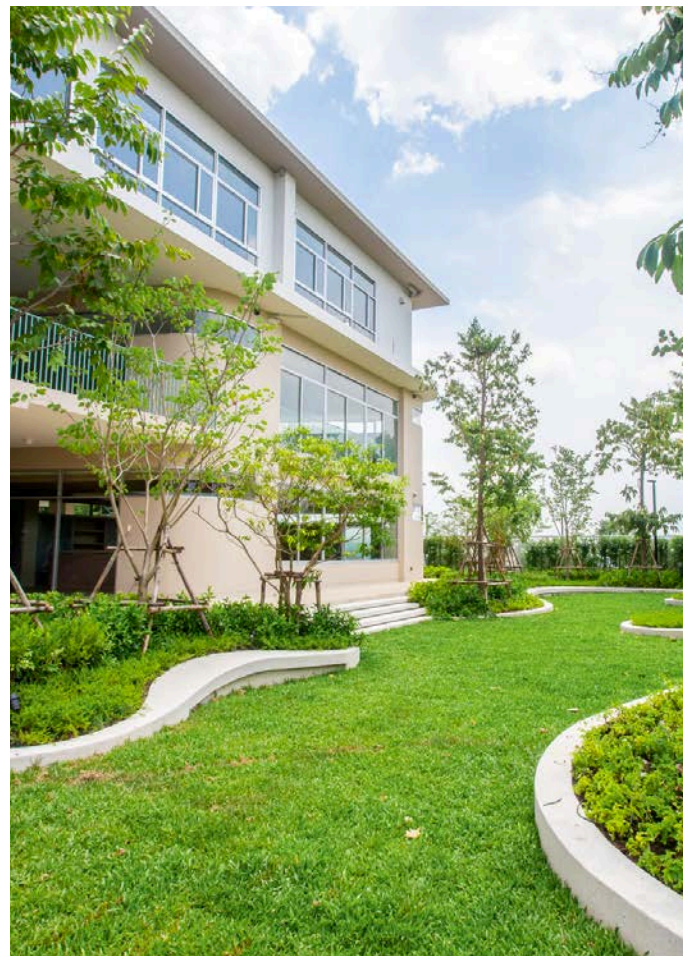

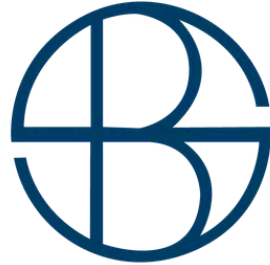
